

EVENT COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES – SPRING HUNT
April 2, 2018 – 7:00 p.m.

There was discussion about ownership of items in trailer and at storage unit. There will be a meeting of representatives at the storage unit to determine ownership. Al K. was asked to be at meeting as he has most knowledge of Pheasant Forever property.

As in the past Jeff M. will prepare food which will be available throughout the day. There will not be a sit-down meal.
